

Schieveling Plantation Pool Rules/Signs

Signs to Be Posted on the Three Gates

PRIVATE PROPERTY – NO TRESPASSING

- Only Schieveling Plantation residents and their invited guests may use this pool. All others will be treated as trespassers.
- Schieveling Plantation assumes no responsibility for loss or damage to personal property or for injury to persons, either members or guests, suffered as a result of utilization of swimming pool facilities. There is no lifeguard on duty. Use of the pool is at your own risk.
- Before entering the pool, you must take a shower.
- No animals or pets are allowed in the pool or inside the pool fence.
- Please see the rest of the pool rules posted on the pump house.

SCHIEVELING PLANTATION POOL RULES

1. No solo swimming, running or boisterous/rough play.
2. Please remember that the pool is for the enjoyment of all members, and courtesy and consideration of each other's rights will lead to everyone's enjoyment.
3. No children under 13 allowed in pool without adult supervision.
4. Leak-proof swimsuits ("swimmies") are required for all children that are not toilet trained; persons in charge of the child (ren) are responsible for cleaning up any "accidents" including those occurring in the pool. Pool must be closed for shock treatment. Notify Pat Provost at 573-0800 immediately, and post the "Closed Because of Contamination" signs on the two access gates.
5. Persons under the influence of alcohol or drugs are not allowed in the pool.
6. No spitting or blowing nose in the pool.
7. Persons with illness (e.g., diarrhea, nausea), with infections (e.g., skin, eye, ear, or respiratory), and/or with open lesions or wounds are not allowed in the pool.
8. No glass or littering allowed in the pool or on the pool deck.

The pool is open between 6:00 AM and 11:00 PM.

The maximum number of swimmers allowed in the pool is 105.

A first aid kit is located on the pump house wall; an emergency phone and a first aid kit are located on the club house porch wall facing the pool pump house.

The certified pool operator at this facility is posted.
